### **New Business**

- Rules Committee:
  - K: Membership in the Beloit Rifle Club does not allow for a member to use the club for profit either individually or as a member of another group, unless specifically approved by the Beloit Rifle Club Board of Directors. Each specific event must be approved.

- (1) "Specific Event" approval procedure.
  - (a) All applications for a "Specific Event", must be initiated by a BRC Member who begins the process by contacting the Executive Committee.
  - (b) All current Range Rules apply.
  - (c) Proof of insurance covering the instructor and group being instructed. Club, Directors and Members to be listed as additional insurers.
  - (d) Instructor to student ratio must be at least one instructor to 2 students when there will be live fire instruction on the range.
  - (e) When there is a charge to the student for the instruction, and/or the Discipline Range is to be closed to regular Club members:
    - (i) For ½ day (4 hours or less) of "Specific Event" use, \$25.00 per student.
    - (ii) For full day (8 hours Greater than 4 hours) of "Specific Event" use, \$50.00 per student.
    - (iii) A Board Member must be present.
    - (iv) There must be at least a 4-week notification.
  - (f) "Specific Event" must be scheduled for a Discipline Range.
- (2) Board of Directors can modify any of the above conditions, except "a, b & c".
  - \*Motion to add Club, Directors and Members to be listed as additional insurers on the policy for C (Paul Schuler) Tim Keinbaum. Discussion. **Voted and Approved**
  - \*Motion to add "/or" after and to E (Rob Lowery) Second (Larry Abbott) Discussion.
