 - Update on Pole Barn build. Building is up minus the overhead door. This is on back order due to spring availability. May have it in November or December. Brad Mueller brought up the local township inspector wasn't informed of the posts being set; he wasn't very happy about it. Brad made it known Rob Lowery was in charge of the build, he did mention that he was the one that got the permit though. Also mentioned there is no clear direction for when to call for inspections. Brad was informed it was already taken care of.
 - Shipping: 4 flat beds, tarped, shipment split into two days.
 - Gallano - \$4800-\$5000 per load
 - Ecogistics - \$4300 each load. Motion to use Ecogistics (Don Miller) Second (Jon Nortemann) **Voted and Approved.**
 - Meiborg - \$4833 per load.
 - Coyote – (A UPS Company Broker) \$4300 each load.
 - Working on a quote to have a rigging company here to unload trucks with fork lift.
