Committee Updates

- Long Term Planning / Capital Improvements – Kyle Schliem and Rob Lowery
 - It is official! We have secured the used indoor Action Target range guts for \$285,000
 - Trucking – while we have a year in contract to move, we would like it here in 60-90 days. That is the goal.
 - Working on getting an idea of the weight for how many loads it will be. Once done we can gather quotes easier. The seller is working on this for us. **(This may get voted on in an email depending on timing.)**
 - Storage – Rob Lowery
 - Shipping containers – original thoughts.
 - \$4100 delivered now. Hard to find. Would need 4 @ &16,400.00.
 - A club member has a manufacturing storage inn Rockford @\$3.50 to \$4.00 per sqft per month. Around 1000 sqft would be \$3500 to \$4000 per month. Would also need transportation of equipment to the club when building is ready.
 - Member also has tractor trailers he could put in.... again, would need 4 @\$150 per month = \$600 per month. To store on our grounds to move the trailer to the club would be \$200 each trailer each way. (\$800)
 - A 30x40x10 pole barn installed on the club grounds is \$18,000. We would have other quotes for this, but this is the most cost efficient one at this time. Builder can install by end of September or beginning of October. Builder reference from Roger Hager's contractor. Motion made to purchase pole barn through contractor JH Construction (Jeff Stevens) Second (Dennis Munn). Discussion. **Voted and Approved**
 - Working in securing appointments with architects now for the range building.
