A reminder regarding current members. The small padlock key will also be used as the main gate key. We are changing the padlocks again this year. That will go into effect February 11, 2024. Your current padlock key will not work after February 11, 2024. If you do not have a current key to exchange, a new key will be \$5.00. I have included a payment schedule so that you can determine your cost for renewal.

PAYMENT OF DUES: Most of the payment of dues occurs at the Dues Collection Day, February 11, 2024. The dues collection will be at Boundaries Bar and Grill. Dues will be collected from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. It is important to remember that your range key, padlock key, will not work after February 11, 2024. If you cannot make the first collection, there will be alternate dates for you to renew, collection on those dates will be at the Beloit Rifle Club clubhouse.

REMINDER: When mailing, your padlock key will need to be taped securely to your BRC Membership card. Your NRA membership status and payment are also required. A new BRC Membership card and padlock key will be mailed to you. Your check will be cashed after Feb. 11, 2024. Include your E-mail address if you want confirmation that your check has been received.

SIGHT-IN DAYS 2023

Shout out to all the 122 plus volunteers who helped make this happen again this year! We had very good weather conditions all 5 days. Cool mornings with warmer afternoons and light wind speeds.

The total number of guns registered this year was 682 with 527 people registering them. A little off last years 719 and 541 respectively. *(see below registered licenses issued from the DNR 2023 season) Report from Milwaukee Journal Sentinel Raffle ticket sales were also a little behind 2022 sales but still added to the overall profit for Beloit Riffle Club. Sales were over 8200 total sales with over 2400 be purchased during the 5 days by those who attended. The \$300 awarded to the person selling the largest amount went to Kyle Schliem. Over 2100 tickets he sold.

Winners were notified by phone and even one was present during the drawing.

* DNR sold 554,898 gun deer licenses, a 1.6% year-over-year decline. The 2023 kill included 85,390 bucks (down 15% from 2022) and 88,552 antlerless deer (down 20%). All four deer management regions showed lower year-over-year deer registrations, with the central farmland at 98,283 (down 17%), southern farmland at 41,349 (down 7%), northern forest at 28,020 (down 30%) and central forest at 6,290 (down 20%).

Code of Conduct

Beloit Rifle Club members and guest are expected to follow this code of conduct and will be held to high standards. Members and guests are expected to display mutual respect, integrity, sportsmanship and be compliant with club rules. There is to be no threatening of one another, physical aggression and there is zero tolerance for any form of discrimination. Members are expected to protect the reputation of the club and take personal responsibility for their actions.

Accountability

Beloit Rifle Club members will be held accountable for their and their guest's actions. Members who violate the rules, our Code of Conduct or our policies may be subject to disciplinary actions, up to and including termination. Violations will be reviewed and disciplinary action is up to the discretion of the Executive Board and the Chief Range Officer. Our disciplinary procedure and bylaws will act as a guide.

Emergency Plan

The BRC board has developed and implemented an emergency plan for the club. We have prepared an action plan with the Beloit Township Fire Department and most importantly informing the membership in what to do in an emergency. Each range has the below sign displayed. Please familiarize yourself with it and think of how you will handle an emergency situation if it arises. The sign is as simple as we can make it but with as much information as possible.

EMERGENCY

(Requiring Medical Attention)

- Call 911 / Administer aide.
- Go to gate, open & direct emergency vehicle if able.
- Cease fire and make firearms safe on all ranges at the club if possible.
- Call BRC President or next in line to report.
- DO NOT MAKE ANY STATEMENTS TO ANY MEDIA OR SOCIAL NETWORKS.
- Take notes, fill out incident report and keep witnesses at scene.

GATE A: BLACK POWDER RANGE

Call 911 / Administer Aide

- If you have to call 911, start now thinking about how you are going to word it... train your brain to say, "I have a medical emergency at the Beloit Rifle Club." NOT "Some guy just shot the guy next to him". Your wording could determine if we have the S.W.A.T. team descend on the club which would hold up the paramedics from helping you or your friend and avoid an intense sweep of the club.
- Administer Aide to the best of your ability. There are emergency kits in the Clubhouse, Main Range shack, Black Powder Lodge, back 100yrd/500m range shack and by Cowboy. We will be improving these and keeping them updated. Please be respectful and do not take what is not needed.

Go to gate, open & direct emergency vehicle

• If you are able or can send someone to unlock the gate and direct emergency personnel. If not, they will go to a key box on the main gate to get onto the property. Be sure to tell the 911 call center what gate and range you are at. (Last line on all signs)

Cease fire and make firearms safe on all ranges at the club if possible

• The fire department asked us to do this due to the current atmosphere. The ambulance may not enter the club if there is continued gun fire and they do not know the situation, or they may just grab and run.

Emergency Plan Continued...

- · If there is someone else available, have them go to other ranges and call a cease fire and make all firearms safe. They may resume once emergency personnel has left.
- · If it sounds like emergency personnel is entering or near club property, cease fire and make all firearms safe until you know what is happening.
- Help spread the word and make the emergency personnel feel safe on our property.

Call BRC President or next in line to report.

• Call the club President, VP, Secretary or Treasurer until you reach one of them to report that there has been a medical emergency so they can get to the club and help deal with anything that they would need to. Their phone numbers are on your card that should be with you at all times on the property.

DO NOT MAKE ANY STATEMENTS TO ANY MEDIA OR SOCIAL NETWORKS

- If the media happens to come out, do not make any comments to them. The Board will appoint someone to speak with the media and will take care of it. We have to protect our club and the media may take something out of context that can hurt us as a whole because of an untrained remark, it could be detrimental to the club.
- Do not post anything on a social network about what has happened. Social network images or statements can also be detrimental, so please do not take a picture and say, "Look at what just happened at Beloit Rifle Club".

· The media casts a negative light on stories dealing with firearms, it is not a time to get involved in gossiping and spreading what you know. It is best to let the professionals handle these situations.

Take notes, fill out incident report and keep witnesses at the scene

- There will be file holders with each sign that will hold paper and pens in order to do this. This will be for any emergency personnel and our insurance company.
- In the file holder will also be incident reports. These are required by our insurance company so please fill out to the best of your ability. Give it to the board member that is there or place in guest fee/admission box inside club house
- Keep the witnesses at the scene until emergency personnel have taken any needed statements from them. Witnesses should also take notes as to what happened.

The last line on the sign will be our address and where you are at on the range. We have coordinated a map with the fire department to make this as seamless as possible in an emergency. Please think about what you will do in an emergency, spread the word, talk about it, and ask questions if you have them. This is extremely important on so many levels.
